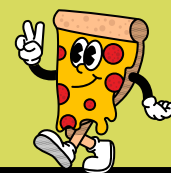
**Classroom Teacher Appointment**

It's impressive to see so many students achieving these rewards.



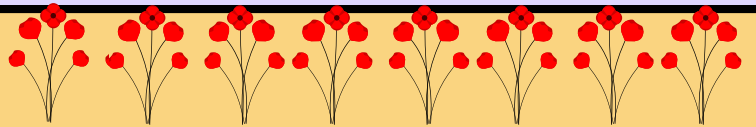
**Cross Country**

Congratulations to all those students who will progress to the next level. Thank you to Mr Darby and all staff for their organisation and support.



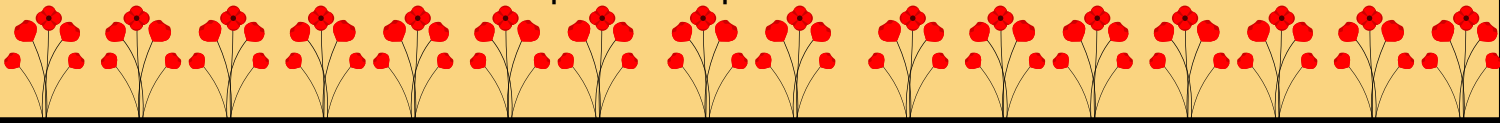

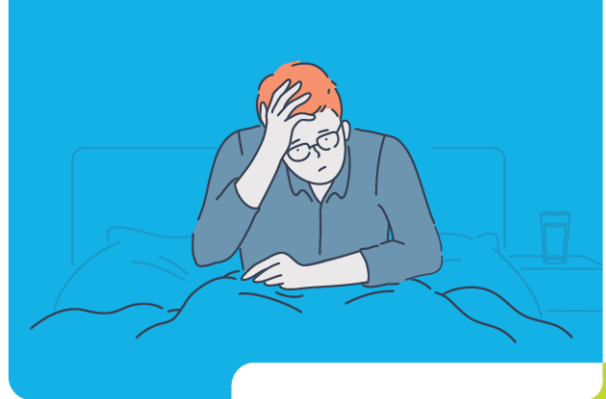
